

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-R-16

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE RESULTS OF THE DRAWING OF LOTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE ORDINANCE, TITLED, TERMS OF OFFICE, ADOPTED NOVEMBER 18, 2003, ESTABLISHING STAGGERED, TWO-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Village of Volente is a newly created governmental entity that was incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas as a Type B General-Law Municipality following an election held on February 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City Council (i.e. Board of Aldermen) approved an ordinance in accordance with Texas Local Government Code allowing the establishment of staggered, two-year terms of office on November 18, 2003; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code requires that selection of the two aldermen who will serve two-year terms shall be determined by drawing lots at the first meeting of the governing body following the annual municipal election held after the ordinance is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the results of the drawing held May 28, 2004 are as follows:

Scott Attwood	1	Year Term
Bill Connors	1	Year Term
Ron Montanez	2	Year Term
Carey M. Witt	2	Year Term
Dan Thost	1	Year Term; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council (i.e. Board of Aldermen) of the Village of Volente, County of Travis, State of Texas:

Section 1: That this is the first meeting of the newly-elected City Council (i.e. Board of Aldermen) following the annual municipal election of the Village of Volente;

Section 2: That at the municipal election, held May 15, 2004, that Jan Yenawine was elected Mayor and Scott Attwood, Bill Connors, Ron Montanez, Carey Witt and Dan Thost were elected as Council members (Aldermen) for said Village and all participated in the drawing of lots for which a quorum was present and for which due notice was given.

Section 3: That the results of the drawing of lots, are that the offices for the Mayor, Alderman RON MONTANEZ, and Alderman CAREY WITT shall be two-years and that the terms of the remaining three aldermanic offices shall remain one-year and that these duly elected offices shall hold these positions for the above terms, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

PASSED and APPROVED by the City Council (i.e. Board of Aldermen) of the Village of Volente at a meeting on the 28th day of May, 2004, by a vote of 5 (ayes) to 0 (nays) to 0 (abstentions) of the City Council (i.e. Board of Aldermen) of the Village of Volente, Texas.
