

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-O-64_

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-O-38 TO INCLUDE THE 2003 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE APPENDIX A –G; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Village of Volente desires to protect its citizens from fire and safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Volente finds that the implementation of the requirements and additional appendix A – G in the 2003 International Fire Code (“Fire Code”) will help protect its citizens from fire and safety hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE:

1. The Volente of Volente Ordinance 2005-O-38, adopting the 2003 International Fire Code passed and approved January 18, 2005, is amended as follows:

(a) The 2003 International Fire Code is adopted by the Village as its Fire Code with the inclusion of the Appendix A - G and is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

2. SEVERABILITY

In the event that any provision of this Ordinance shall be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such void or unenforceable provision shall be severed, and all remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect as though such void or unenforceable provisions had never formed a part of this Ordinance.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of its enacting ordinance with the provisions of *Chapter 52 of the Teas Local government Code.*

4. OPEN MEETINGS: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which the enacting ordinance of this article is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapter 551 of the Texas Local Government Code.*

PASSED AND APPROVED this, the 16th day of May, 2006, by a vote of the Volente Village Council of 5 in favor to 0 opposed with 0 abstentions.
