

Public Works Committee Report

The Public Works Committee has moved beyond the early priorities of Right of Way clearing and mowing (work that is now complete) to drainage improvements where significant issues have been brought to our attention. We have identified five areas for us to focus on

1. Intersection of Joy, Sharon, and West
2. Intersection of West and Lime Creek Road on the upper side
3. Along Lime Creek Road close to the Village Limits – large wash out
4. Booth Circle between Steichen and Brown property involving culvert under Booth Circle

The committee has met on site and reviewed each situation. We have written recommendations on items 1 and 2 in the list above. I am including pictures of the work done for item 3 – both before and after. Item 4 will be address later in the summer once an effective design is agreed to.

The committee also did an ad hoc meeting onsite at a property along Lime Creek to review the requirements for drainage under a driveway to be constructed. The committee made a recommendation and construction is proceeding.

A significant “shout out” goes to Gary Frame who has made himself available to the committee as a “subject expert” on drainage for us to call on for help.
