

VILLAGE OF VOLENTE

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE MINOR EXPENDITURES RELATED TO START-UP COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NEW VILLAGE ADMINISTRATION.

Whereas, the Village of Volente is a newly-created governmental entity that was incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas as a Type B General-Law Municipality following an election held on February 1, 2003; and

Whereas, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, the Mayor and Village Alderman ("Council") were duly elected following an election held May 3, 2003; and

Whereas, the Council intends to diligently pursue adoption of a Village budget and recognizes there may be minor administrative start-up costs prior to adoption of the Village's first budget (including office supplies & liability insurance); and

Whereas, the Council finds that the Mayor is the Village Administrator and official budget officer.

Now therefore, be it hereby resolved by the Council of the Village of Volente, Texas, that effective immediately upon passage:

- A. Mayor Jan Yenawine is authorized to expend funds on behalf of the Village, not to exceed a combined total amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). The Mayor may receive additional spending authority with City Council approval.
- B. The Mayor shall submit receipts to the City Council for approval at the next regular meeting following the expenditure.
