RESOLUTION 2007-R-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF JONESTOWN IN UPHOLDING STRICT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS ON THE SHORES OF LAKE TRAVIS TO ENSURE CONTINUING EXCELLENT WATER QUALITY.

WHEREAS, Lake Travis has a high rating for water clarity and purity which could be negatively impacted by high density development;

WHEREAS, other cities that share water frontage on Lake Travis are maintaining strict standards of density and impervious cover and some are reevaluating and revising their standards to be more diligent in preserving the quality of the lake water;

WHEREAS, the Village of Volente has continued to stand firm in the face of litigation to keep the rural quality of the Highland Lakes and Hill Country and to protect Lake Travis; and

WHEREAS, development on all shores of Lake Travis impact all property owners whether inside or outside of city limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS, that in the spirit of solidarity, our governing body supports you in your vigilance and maintenance of your development standards in the face of development pressure for high density in a rural Hill Country, Highland Lakes setting.
