

ORDINANCE 2010-O-117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS CHANGING THE NAME OF HILL STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE TO YENAWINE WAY; PROVIDING FOR SERVERABILITY AND COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT.

WHEAREAS, the Village would like to honor our founding Mayor by renaming Hill Street after him, and

WHEAREAS, there is currently no residence on Hill Street and the roadway is currently used as a driveway for the Volente Fire Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The findings and recitations set out above in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and that they are hereby adopted by the Village Council and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. Changing the Name of Hill Street. The Village Council of the Village of Volente hereby changes the name of Hill Street to Yenawine Way.

Section 3. Severability. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Village Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, sentence, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Village Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. Open Meetings. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings, *Act, Chapt. 511, Tex. Gov't. Code*.
