

City Secretary Report for June, 2013

Construction Report:

A swimming pool was permitted at 8132 Beauregard. The application was received on 6-10-2013 and permitted on 6-25-2013. The first review by TRE & Associated, LLC on June 17th asked for additional information regarding screening the mechanical equipment, impervious cover calculations, and location of the underground electrical service to the pool. The pool is now permitted and being constructed.

There are two homes under construction on Jackson Street both are passing inspections as is the Osorio home on Booth Circle. There is a remodel permit for a home on Dodd Street that is very close to being completed.

8212 West Drive is permitted and the Village is communicating with the realtor representing the owner of the lots regarding the plat he will be submitting in Travis County for subdividing the lots.

Training:

I contacted our municipal judge regarding a training for municipal judges on the magistrate's role in traffic safety and made arrangements for him to attend this school in Austin. He reported that he did attend and received 5.5 hrs of judicial education certification credit for the classes. Our city manager and myself attended a webinar training presented by Texas Municipal League on PPACA-affordable health care act.
