**RESOLUTION NO: 2020-R- 09**

**GENERAL ELECTION CANVASS OF RETURNS**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION, HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO (2) COUNCIL MEMEBERS.**

**WHEREAS, On August 17, 2020, the Village Council ordered a General Election to be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November 2020, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two (2) Council Members; and**

**WHEREAS, notice of the election was duly published in the Hill Country News on October 8, 2020, and a copy of the notice was posted at City Hall; and**

**WHEREAS, this election was duly and legally held on November 3, 2020 in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of the election have been certified and returned by the Travis County Elections Division; and**

**WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and the Council finds, that the election was in all aspects lawfully held; and**

**WHEREAS, it appears to the Council, and the Council finds, that the tabulation of the results of the election are correct.**

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1. The General Election of November 3, 2020 was duly called, notice of said election was given and was held in accordance with the law.**

**SECTION 2. The tabulation of votes cast in the General Election held on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of election a Mayor and two (2) Village Council Members, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance is adopted as the official tabulation of the votes cast at the election, and the tabulation will be filed and recorded in the official records of the Village of Volente, as the official canvass of the election.**

**SECTION 3. The official canvass of the returns of the election reflects the following:**

**A. For Mayor position, the following candidates received votes as follows:**

- **Jana Nace                      148**
- **Dan Thost                      246**

**B. For two (2) Council Member positions, the following candidates received votes as follows:**

- Kit Hopkins                    196
- Donovan Dixon                114
- AJ Forsythe                    118
- Kristin Ruff                    217
- Judy Barrick                    49

**SECTION 4.**

**A. From said returns, the Mayor candidate receiving the most votes cast in said election, the following candidate is hereby duly elected as Mayor for the Village of Volente, Texas:**

- Dan Thost

**B. From said returns, the two (2) candidates receiving the most votes cast in said election, the following candidates are hereby duly elected as Council Members for the Village of Volente, Texas:**

- Kristin Ruff
- Kit Hopkins

The above-named persons are hereby duly elected at said election and shall take their respective offices upon their qualification therefore, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.


**SECTION 5. The Mayor of the Village of Volente is authorized to execute and the Village Secretary is authorized to attest to this Resolution on behalf of the Village Council. The Mayor is further authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.**

**SECTION 6. This Resolution is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.**


**SECTION 7. A quorum of the Council was present at the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted. The meeting was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551 of the Teas Government Code.**

**PASSED AND APPROVED** this, the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2020, by a vote of 5 ayes, 0 nays, 0 abstentions of the Council of the Village of Volente, Texas.
