Last Meeting

The Public Safety Committee last met on Tuesday, May 4th. Minutes will be posted by Friday, May 21st.

Update & Goals

Maintain the safety of Volente streets by maintaining police presence as long as Travis County resources allow.

Maintain the safety of Volente streets by implementing additional speed and racing deterrents (i.e., speed humps/cushions, slow down electronic signage on Lime Creek.

Maintain the safety of Volente by installing stop signs at the following locations:

- Lime Creek/Wharf Cove/FM2769 – 3-way stop
- Mary Street to Brandy Way – 3-way stop
- Dodd Street/Mary Street/Lime Creek – 4-way stop

Maintain the safety of Volente, by having holiday/summer police presence on:

- Memorial Day – Monday, May 27th (12pm – 11pm) 11 hours of coverage
- Friday & Saturday nights (May 28 – July 31: 9pm-12am) 20 days @ 3 hours per day
- Independence Day – Sunday, July 4th (12pm-11pm) 11 hours of coverage

Request of Council

Approve scheduling of special called council meeting to:

- Review, discuss and approve budget amendment to add cost of speed cushions, electronic sign, and adding 5 stop signs
- Review, discuss, and approve (if required) to engage (1) officer with Travis County sheriff department for holiday and weekend coverage at Wharf Cove/Lime Creek & Dodd/Mary Street

Potential Budget Addition

4 – speed cushions \$255 - \$1300 a piece, depending on design and size

5 stop signs – price TBD
