

Public Works Committee March/April 2014 progress report:

Our main efforts since our last Council meeting has been clearing the ditches of brush along Sherman, Arron Terrace, Jackson, Bernard, Beauregard, West, Joy and Lime Creek and from the intersection of Mary Street to 7903 Lime Creek. The brush removal crew did a timely and professional job of clearing the drainage ways of brush so the Public Works Committee can determine where drainage maintenance needs to occur and road failure points are located. Street meetings will be necessary for part of this. The actual brush clearing line item fell two days short of job completion. The completion is important enough that I used part of the funds council moved to this road maintenance project since drainage is part of road maintenance. At specific intersections and road locations while the crew was clearing low hanging brush, we addressed line of sight, height, and width issues for the school busses and fire department. At this time the budget line item brush clearance is exhausted and no more brush will be cleared unless council requires it or the new budget cycle kicks in. Much of Lime Creek is in dire need of brush clearance for traffic safety.

The survey for Booth Circle at Wharf Cove is completed. In the area that the culvert problem exists the Village right of Way is well within our immediate construction needs. The Public Works Committee will be meeting in the very near future to determine where to focus on drainage maintenance and review the surveyors information.
