A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS OF THE CANVAS AND CERTIFICATION AS TO THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS, ON MAY 7, 2016.

WHEREAS, there came to be an election held on the 7th day of May, 2016, for the Consideration of two propositions; and

WHEREAS, it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there was cast at said election valid and legal ballots; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Kit Hopkins moved adoption of this Resolution herein set forth, with the motion being seconded by Council Member Andy Fogarasi and the Resolution being adopted with five Council Members voting “yes” with no Council Members voting “no”.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VOLENTE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That said Special Election of the Village of Volente, held on the 7th day of May, 2016 was duly called, that notice of said election was given, and that said election was held in accordance with the law.

Section 2: That at said Special Election for the Village of Volente Proposition 1 failed and Proposition 2 passed, resulting in a withdrawal from the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority and subsequent creation of a 1% sales and use tax for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

Section 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and public notice was given as required by the *Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code*.
